Thank God that in June, before this busy season, a leadership team from a church in Chişinău was able to attend a retreat led by Innovista trainers.

- That the reflection and rest facilitated by Innovista will reenergise this team as they return to a busy church schedule of youth work, worship and outreach.
- That as other leaders and churches see the impact
- that this retreat has had, their own attitude to rest will begin to change.

Last year, in partnership with the Praxis Network, Innovista helped design and deliver the Seol course.

Thank God that over 56 facilitators were trained from 14 churches. They delivered the course to equip more than 250 people to more effectively 'do mission' in their everyday lives.

- For facilitators from new churches to get involved as preparations are made for the next round of training in the autumn, building on learning from last year.
- That leaders who took part in facilitation training last year will encourage more people to get involved, especially
- those who wouldn't normally consider themselves as 'leaders'.
- That as more people are equipped to be braver in sharing their faith, their families, friends and colleagues will come to know Jesus.
